

DIA-TRAIN

DIA-TRAIN is a diversified two-week programme to identify and ascertain competencies of a learner or candidate. The DIAGNOSIS and TRAINING tools are geared to students in transition from school to work. The module offers participants various possibilities of demonstrating and experiencing their own competencies and provides teachers with a remedial diagnostic foundation for their work. The module, as customised for Abu Dhabi, comprises the exercises

- social training
- narrative interview
- creativity training
- learning training as well as
- exercises for self assessment.

The performance of the participants is systematically observed in all exercises, and the results are documented in a "support report" which will assist teachers in optimising subsequent learning steps.

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DIA-TRAIN for teachers and facilitators is a module of further training for professionals in education and training of ten-day duration. The module design is based on recent scientific research and combines theoretical knowledge and practical exercises (hands-on approach). As part of the practical application every participant has to execute and evaluate a DIA-TRAIN course with students of one of the Abu Dhabi Institutes for Vocational Education and Training (VETI). The module comprises the following elements:

- Introduction of Action Orientated Competency Assessment
- Social Training
- Creativity Training
- Observation Training
- Learning Training
- Biographical Interview
- Support Report
- Implementation / Organisation

Mr. James Miller participated in the DIA-TRAIN module organised in Al Ain during September 7th to 18th, 2008, and has passed the final assessment; he has successfully conducted and evaluated a DIA-TRAIN course in English medium and submitted a "support report".

The DIA-TRAIN certificate qualifies him to apply DIA-TRAIN methods in the Vocational Education and Training Institutes in Al Ain und Al Gharbia (Emirate of Abu Dhabi) as well as in training and education institutions holding a DIA-TRAIN license in Germany in compliance with DIA-TRAIN standards.
